The City Council of Knox and Waste Management are happy to announce the launch of EVERY-OTHER-WEEK recycling services. We look forward to helping your community remain clean – and green – in 2016 and beyond.

New Recycling Carts

Each residence of the City of Knox is receiving a new 64-gallon green cart with a yellow lid for recycling. Simply combine all of your acceptable recyclable materials in the cart and place it at the curb on Wednesday every other week. Please see the Recycling Collection Calendar on the back of this brochure to determine the Green recycling collection weeks.

Collection Times

Place your recycling cart at the curb no later than 6 a.m. on your collection day. Make sure that the cart is at least three feet from your mailbox, vehicles or other items, and that the handle faces away from the road. After collection, please remove your cart by the end of the day.

Observed Holidays

Waste Management observes the following holidays. When your collection falls on or after one of these holidays, your collection will be delayed one day.

Labor Day **Thanksgiving Day** **Christmas Day**

Plus the recycled materials become new products – if you recycle an aluminum can today, it could be back on the shelf as a new one in 60 days – and the cycle continues.

- Use your new cart with the yellow lid for your recyclables – no sorting needed.
- Containers that held food should be rinsed free of food debris and liquid.
- Do not put recyclables in plastic bags.
- Recycling will be collected every other week.

During the holiday weeks of Memorial Day (5/29/17), Labor Day (9/4/17), and Christmas Day (12/25/17) both trash and recycling service will be delayed by one day. For Independence Day (7/4/17) and Thanksgiving (11/23/17), Thursday trash service only will be delayed by one day to Friday. There will be no trash service delay for New Year's Day (1/1/17) since it falls on a Sunday.
