- City Court Hearings are cancelled until further notice. Please use the drop-box for payment of tickets and/or violations, payments can also be paid on-line through the City's website at www.cityofknox.net. If you need assistance or have any questions, please call 574-772-3766.
- 3. Knox Community Center The Community Center will be closed through the end of April. We will be evaluating the situation at the end of April to see if further closure is necessary. If you have rented this facility or a room, you will be contacted to be offered a refund or a chance to reschedule. - 4. The Girl Scout Cabin The Girl Scout Cabin will no longer be available and will be closing permanently on April 30<sup>th</sup>.
