

The Common Council of the City of Knox met in regular session Tuesday, March 8, 2022, in the Knox Community Center at 6:00 P.M. CST with the following members present: Mayor Dennis Estok; Clerk-Treasurer Cyndi Kidder; Council Members Jeff Berg, Bill Gustafson, Sherry Cowen, Ron Parker and City Attorney Autumn Ferch. RE: APPROVAL OF MINUTES REGULAR MEETING 2/22/22
