Old Business

- Truck Update

- Equipment Purchase Update
 - o All equipment was purchased for \$5,500.
- 5 Year Park Plan
 - Working on getting the public survey ready. The board decided to just use the same survey as before.

New Business

- Ball Diamond 5 Relocation
 - Karl wants to move ball diamond 5 so it faces a different direction. One reason would be so the fence isn't by the hill. This will prevent sledding accidents.
 - Motion Nathan, 2nd Gary. All in favor
- Lights at Volleyball Courts
 - Karl wants to install lights near the volleyball courts. Recently by the time the 2nd game started it was too dark to see.
 - o There is power over there and old Nipsco poles in the back as well as lights.
 - The board could consider this as an option in the future.
 - o It was also discussed to look into installing lights at the basketball court.
- Patronicity Grant
 - o Karl has located a grant which is a \$50,000 matching grant. It is a crowd funding grant.
 - o Board discussed grant and agreed to have Karl think of projects that could be covered by grant.

- Written Park Policies
 - Recently people have been asking to have bounce houses in the park. In June of 2020 the board voted to not permit bounce houses in the park.
 - o It is time for the board to come up with written policies on what is and isn't allowed when renting shelters and/or the band stage.
 - o The board is to think of things to include in this policy.

 - o Motion to approve Karl moving forward with the scoreboard donation.

- Trunk or treat is scheduled for October 27th from 4-5:30 in the park.
- Sarah Shaw, who works for INDOT, has contacted Karl wanting to have an adult softball tournament on October 8th in the park. She has requested the fee be waived because the money raised is donated to a charity.
 - Motion to waive fee Nathan, 2nd Ruth. All in favor
- Working on the floors in the old concession stand bathrooms.
- Port a pots have been returned to Johnsons and now using the ones owned by the city.
- Karl is going to talk to SKILL about welding a gate for field 4.
- The pavilion is done, Jeremiah Patrick is going to fill in the ruts in the grass.
- There is a Softball Tournament on the weekend of October 28th. So far there is 17 teams signed up.
- Karl suggests that the fields be recrowned. Warsaw purchased a machine that we could
 use for this.
 - o Motion to spend up to \$2,500 to recrown fields
